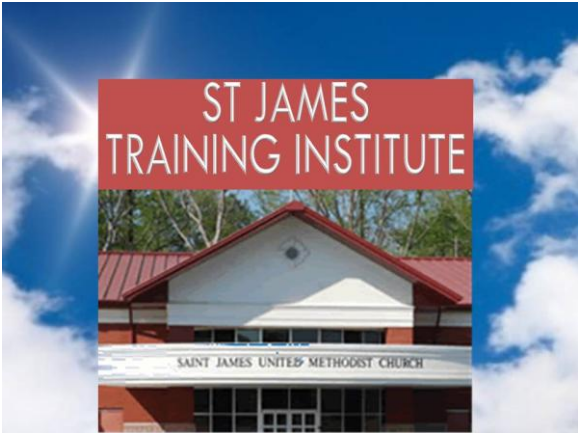


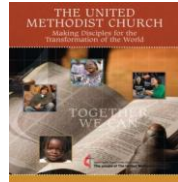

United Methodism 101: Making Disciples for the Transformation of the World

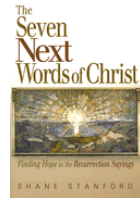

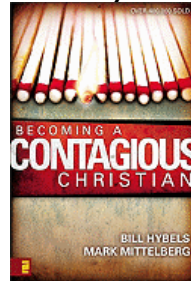

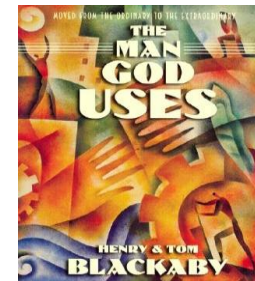
