March 1		1st Sunday in Lent Psalm 32– “Return in the Blessedness and Relief of Forgiveness!”
March 2 Monday	Phil. 3:20-21	Lord Jesus, thank you for the promise of a day of redemption, when our bodies will be transformed gloriously. Grant us grace that we may increase our faith and love for You as we wait for your promised return. In Your Name we lift up our praises and we pray. Amen
March 3 Tuesday	Phil. 3:21	Father God we are “pressing on the upward way, new heights we are gaining every day.” As we look forward to that day You will return to transform our lowly bodies; we claim your promise to be conformed to Your glorious body. In Jesus’ Name we pray. Amen
March 4 Wednesday	1 Thess. 5:23	Heavenly Father, please sanctify us, purify our hearts, and make us holy like you. We ask that the God of peace Himself sanctify us entirely; and may our spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. IJN, Amen.
